
OUR MISSION


OUR HISTORY

The historic Valentine Theatre opened its doors on Christmas Day in 1895 and is currently a 901-seat facility operated by the Toledo Cultural Arts Center, Inc. Following a 21year effort by the Board of Trustees and the community, the newly renovated theatre was reopened on October 9, 1999. Since then, more than a million people have attended international, national and regional presentations, weddings and events.





GTCF's Innovation & Excellence Awards

The Valentine Theatre was honored to be this year's recipient of the annual Northwest Ohio Nonprofit Innovation Award from The Greater Toledo Community Foundation and The Blade, in partnership with the Center for Nonprofit Resources, The Andersons, Inc., Buckeye Broadband, and 13abc. Make a TAX-FREE Gift from your IRA

If you are age 70 ½ or older, you can make an annual tax-free gift to The Valentine Theatre from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA). This type of gift is commonly called a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD), and the amount (up to \$100,000) counts toward the Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) from your traditional or Roth IRA. Gifts must be completed before Dec. 31 to be eligible in the current tax year.

Important points to consider:

- You must be at least $70\frac{1}{2}$.
- The gift should come directly to The Valentine Theatre from your IRA account administrator, in the form of a check.
- The gift may come from a Traditional or Roth IRA (special exclusions may apply to other types of IRA accounts).
- Although there is no tax deduction, there is NO income tax on the IRA withdrawal.

What are the advantages?

- Benefit The Valentine Theatre in a meaningful way today.
- Meet your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD).
- Pay no income tax on the amount withdrawn for your gift.
- Give above your deductible charitable limit of 50 percent of adjusted gross income.
